Walking and riding is permitted on all tracks unless otherwise stated on signs.

All riders and dog walkers must leave 'THE LOOK OUT' by the appropriately signed tracks.

**DOGS** - Must be kept under strict control

**FIRE** - Fire can be a serious problem, especially in summer. Please do not light fires or barbecues and be very careful when smoking. Should you discover a fire, contact a Ranger immediately or dial 999 giving the location as accurately as possible.

**LITTER** - As well as spoiling the character of the forest, litter can harm wildlife. Please take your litter home.

You will often see and appreciate more if you walk through the forest quietly. The forest is here to be enjoyed but it is also the wildlife's home.

**FOREST WALK:** (1.2m • 2kms.) Includes pinetum.

**HERITAGE TRAIL:** (4.1m • 6.6kms approx.) Includes Caesar's Camp, Iron age Hill Fort, Redoubts and Wickham Bushes (site of Roman town).

**NATURE TRAIL:** (5.2m • 8.4 kms approx.) Includes a variety of habitats from mature pines and young plantations to heathlands, bogs & lakes.

**RAMBLERS ROUTE (3 Castles Walk):** Runs from 'DEVIL'S HIGHWAY' to the 'THE LOOK OUT' and through Swinley Park to Englemere
